LAKE NEBAGAMON HISTORY:

Frederick Weyerhauser brought his family to Lake Nebagamon in the late 1890's after having established his lumber empire in Illinois and Indiana. The Nebagamon Lumber Company was incorporated June 14, 1898. His son, John Phillip was assigned management of the company, and went onto lay out the mill site and construct seven and one-half miles of track to Hawthorne, Wisconsin to connect with the Omaha Railway. He also Platted the town, built the mill, office, stables, boarding and rooming houses, a store, and other facilities. He built a home for his family which is now the "Big House" at Camp Nebagamon.
