SEPTEMBER BIRTH FLOWERS

September's birth flowers are the **aster** and the **morning glory**. The aster signifies powerful love, and the China aster expresses variety or afterthought in the language of flowers. The morning glory symbolizes affection. It can also mean coquetry, affectation, or bonds in the language of flowers.

SEPTEMBER BIRTHSTONE

The September birthstone is the sapphire, which was once thought to guard against evil and poisoning.

APPLE CINNAMON WAFFLES

INGREDIENTS

1-1/2 cups all-purpose flour

1/2 cup whole wheat flour

1 tablespoon baking powder

2 teaspoons packed brown sugar

1/2 teaspoon ground cinnamon

1/2 teaspoon salt

3 eggs, separated

1 cup milk

1/4 cup melted butter, plus extra for waffle iron

1 teaspoon vanilla extract

1/2 sweet apple, such as Fuji or Gala, cored, and grated

INSTRUCTIONS

Preheat waffle iron.

In a bowl, whisk together flours, baking powder, brown sugar, cinnamon, and salt.

In the bowl of a stand mixer, beat egg whites until soft peaks form. Set aside.

In another bowl, whisk together egg yolks, milk, butter, and vanilla. Stir egg yolk mixture into dry mixture until combined (some lumps are fine). Gently fold in egg whites, then fold in apple.

Brush melted butter over hot waffle iron. Spoon batter into waffle iron and cook for 3 to 5 minutes, or until nicely browned.

YIELD: Makes 4 servings.




