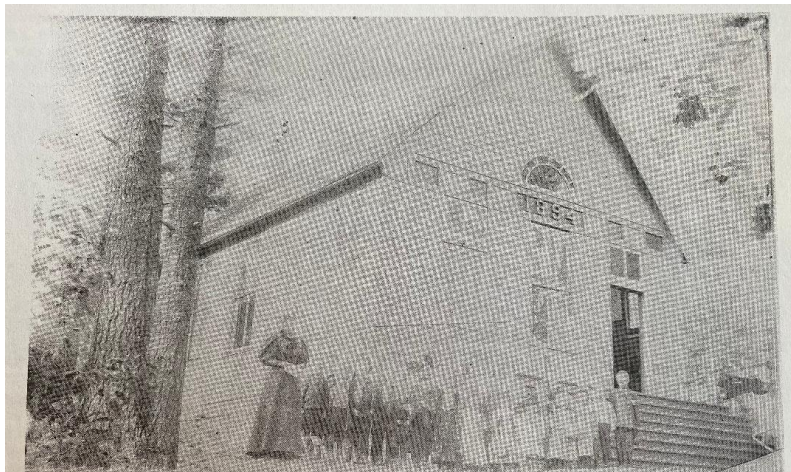

NEBAGAMON HISTORY SPOTLIGHT:

Lake Nebagamon School House



FIRST SCHOOL--This schoolhouse was built in 1894 on the site of the present school at First Street South and Second Avenue West. When the second school was built up on

the hill where the present playground is located, this building was used for the primary grades.

The Lake Nebagamon original school was built by the Weyerhaeuser company in 1894. As Nebagamon grew, a schoolhouse number two was constructed in 1899 by Sam P. Redding and a "good force of men."

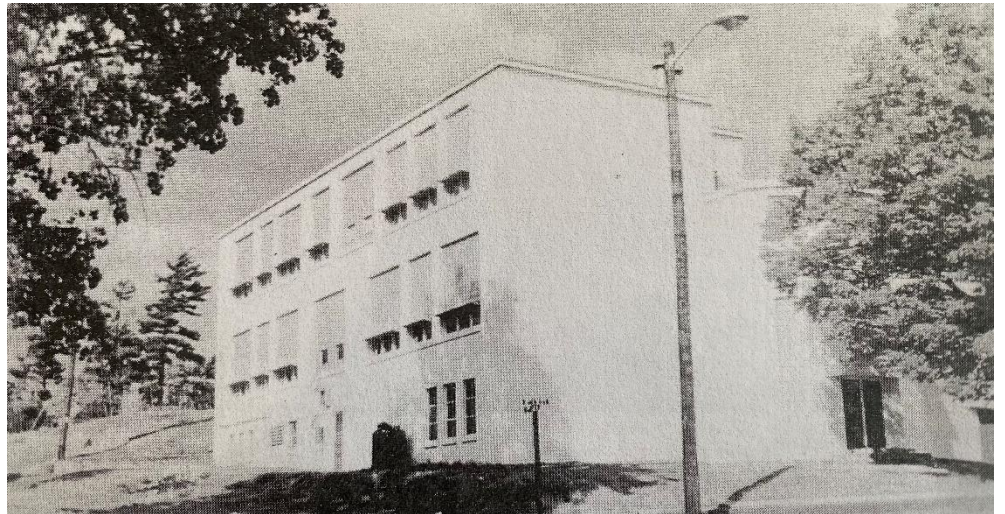


TIME FOR READING, 'RITING, 'RITHMETIC--As Nebagamon grew, so did the need for a bigger school. This schoolhouse was number two, replacing the little building built by the Weyerhaeuser company in 1894. This building was constructed in 1899 by Sam P. Redding and a "good force of men." It was located on what is now the school playground at Second Street S. and Second Avenue W.
