
We are always looking for volunteers or those willing to come to meeting to keep our events alive.

Lake Nebagamon School House




FIRST SCHOOL.-This schoolhouse was built in 1894 on the site of the present school at First Street South and Second Avenue West. When the second school was built up on


NEBAGAMON RESIDENTS:
