We made it through another winter! Finally! The village invested in a street sweeper last fall and the machine worked nicely to pick up the sand on our streets that accumulated over the winter.

The ice left our lake just in time for the fishing opener. Some of you may have noticed bright lights shining out on the lake last week. The DNR has been doing a fishery survey of our lake. The survey involves netting and electro shocking fish to collect information. The captured fish are counted, measured and returned unharmed. With this information, a lake management plan will be developed. Stay tuned for announcements regarding public review of the plan.

We'll be dressing up the storm water retention pond by beach. Volunteers will be needed to help remove invasive plants and plant native plants. I expect this work will take place sometime in the next two months. If you interested in helping, please contact us at the village office.

1908:

New Sidewalks For Downtown Area

The village kept growing and sidewalks were installed - 10,569 square feet of cement, with a material cost of \$375.00. Labor cost was \$573.93, for a total cost of nine cents per square foot.

A contracting firm from Superior offered to build them for 16 cents a square foot with "our village furnishing the plans and doing the filling in." By doing it ourselves, it cost a lot less considering we have 20 barrels of cement left over.

The cement walks built two years ago by the contractor cost us 18 cents a square foot plus the planks and the filling in. \$498.64 of the \$953.97 was paid by the property owners and the rest by the village.

State elections in 1908 elected J.O. Davidson, Governor; John Strange, Lieutenant Governor; J.A. Frear, Secretary of State; F.L. Gilbert, Attorney General; A.H. Dahl, Treasurer, and G.E. Beedle, Insurance Commissioner.

New items included the announcement of the marriage of C.D. Hall to Miss Louise Hall of Lake Nebagamon on Wednesday, November 25, at Iron River by the Rev. E.E. Day. The ceremony was held at the parsonage.

Mr. W.B. Carlin has accepted a position as general manager for the Backus Brooks Lumber Company and left for Keewatin Canada. Mr. Carlin had been with the Nebagamon Lumber Company for nine years. "As a practical mill man, he has few if any

superiors. We are sorry to have him leave us and wish him every success in his new field of labor."

The Jolly Juniors Bachelor's Club gave a dance at the pavilion Thursday, November 26 in honor of the "Sweet 16 Maids." They served an elegant lunch at the midnight hour.
