

Tamburitz.ans Bring World To Nebagamon



The Tamburitzans are a group of unique young people who come here each summer from Duquesne University, located in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania.

Their leader, Matt Guzay, had summered across the lake at the Andy Doran place many times and decided it would be a great place to bring his young singers and dancers for a combination vacation and work.

This would be just the right place for the rehearsals of the Tamburitzan dancers and to swim and play as well as do their summer rehearsing. This was the summer of 1947.

After a couple of years, villagers became aware of the cultural significance of these energetic young people and the "Tammies" were asked to perform on

the village green beind the auditorium, so that the people of the village could see and hear their whole

The Tamburitzans have given their performance here every year and as the interest has spread so widely and the crowds have been getting larger and larger, it has become one of the highlights of the summer season.

Their sojourns here have even led to the composi-

tion of an original song about a popular night spot. "Come to Finell's" and the bonhester song, a song written by Dick Crum about Lake Nebagamon while he was walking on the beach.

The Tamburitzans were founded in 1937 at Duquesne University. They take their name from the Tamburitza family of stringed instruments in-digenous to the folk cultures of southeastern Europe. The group exists for the dual purpose of preserving and perpetuating the Eastern European Cultural heritage in the United States.

The students who make up the performing ensemble come from all parts of America, from various ethnic and religious backgrounds, and may study in any academic area.

They travel thousands of miles throughout the continental United States and Canada, performing 100 concerts within each nine month season. They have also made seven tours outside the United States.

A Tamburitzan performance is like a vacation in Europe. Through the magic of their music, the youthful troupe takes one into pleasant valleys to see the spinning village dances of the peasant; into the rugged mountain country to witness the high leaps and acrobatics of the mountain folk.

A two-hour musical pageant of slavic folk music, songs and dances unfolds in rapid-fire sequence weaving a musical fantasy along the entire length of the mighty Danube River.

Brilliant and authentic costumes of the peasant folk pour forth in all colors of the rainbow, not in gaudy "showy" fashion, but in a subtle and simple true art form of the people. The Tamburitzans possess what is probably the greatest assemblage of authentic peasant dress in the Western Hemisphere. Hundreds of these individual costumes are utilized in every musical production.

The Tamburitzan sings a dozen different European languages, and performs the music and dances of as many countries.

Using the lute-like tamburitza instruments as the oundation of the troupe, the Tamburitzans have developed what is today the finest Tamburitza ensemble in America. The Tamburitza is supported by other traditional instruments such as the accordion, the clarinet and violin.

The chanting of dissonant voices along with the hypnotic beat of the primitive goatskin drum and the hypnotic beat of the primitive goatskin grum and the haunting sounds of the shepherd's flutes add to the unusually interesting quality of their performance.

A whole family of tamburitza instruments grew as

a result of these refinements. A "tamburitza ensem-

ble" now consists of various combinations of bass tamburitzas. cello tamburitzas, "braci." "Bisernice," etc. each fulfilling a function roughly analogous to those of various violins. violas, etc. of a symphony orchestra.

The tamburitza is far from the only instrument used in eastern Europe and the Balkans, however, Flutes, bowed instruments and drums of many kinds provide accompaniment for songs and dances. In fact, in order to present the full picture of this music, the Tamburitzans utilize all of these instruments.

There is, for example, the large goatskin drum known as "tapan" or "tupan." This enormous drum is worn slung around the neck of the player, who beats one side with a heavy wooden stick and the other with a thin sapling twig. The variety of sound effects produced is amazing, and the tapan is an absolutely indispensable component of celebrations in Bulgaria, Macedonia and other parts of the Balkans.

The "zurla." a reeded woodwind instrument, is very harsh to the western ear. In Macedonia, it is always played together with the tupan to accompany dences.

The "Nai" or pipes-of-pan is an ancient Balkan instrument that has died out in most Balkan countries except Romania. Its twenty-odd tubes are carefully hollowed out and cut in appropriate lengths for accurate playing, and if the weather conditions or occasional leaks alter the tone of the tube, the player simply drops a bean or pea into it to re-adjust.

The 'Nai' is becoming rare even in Romania. The one in the Tamburitzans' collection was made especially for the group by an old craftsman, through the courtesy of the Romanian Institute of Folklore in Bucharest.

The "frula" or shepherd's flute is an indispensible instrument added to the unusual and haunting sounds of the Tamburitzans.

Friends of the Tamburitzans

The 80s have brought exciting new possibilities to the Tammies and their summer encampments here. In 1979, a group of interested local residents formed the Friends of the Tamburitzans for the purpose of creating, administering and maintaining the Wisconsin Folk and Cultural Arts Center on the 38-acre Bolognesi estate located just behind the village tennis courts off County Highway B and the Bolognesi Road. The estate includes 1.000 feet of lake frontage: a two-story, six-bedroom home: a "barn" which includes a living room, bath, two bedrooms and a loft; a small caretaker's cottage and a boathouse.

Membership in the organization is open to all who are interested in supporting the project which is based on a feasibility study conducted in 1980 by the Upper Great Lakes Regional Commission. Chiefly, the group is charged with fund-raising efforts for the center.

The original incorporators are Janice Follis. Ernest Vennerstrom, Walter Kolar. Patricia French and Gary Larson. The present officers in 1986 are president Ernest Vennerstrom, vice-president Charles Bergstrom, secretary Imogene McGrath and treasurer Janice Follis.

The board of directors includes Walter Kolar, Patricia French, Ronald Rendulic and Nicholas Jordanoff, all from Pittsburgh. The Lake Nebagamon directors are Allan and Janice Follis. Betty and Ernest Vennerstrom, Imogene McGrath. Oscar Johnson, William Axt, Alex Sprowls and Esther Yaworski. Superior directors are Charles Bergstrom, John Hendricks, Robert Fudally and Virginia Erickson.

As the summer of 1986 approaches, the Tammies are once again preparing for a world tour and when they return to Lake Nebagamon they will have new and exciting stories to tell, music to play and songs and dances to perform.
